What is Five-Act Structure and How Do You Use It?

In 1863 German playwright Gustav Freytag set out what was to become known as the 'dramatic arc'. Freytag identified a five-act structure: exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and dénouement. He produced a pyramid to demonstrate this idea; this is known as the Freytag pyramid. Freytag Pyramid.

The Importance of Structure when Writing: Five-Act Structure

As in the five act structure, the first act of the three act structure established characters and setting, and includes an inciting incident. The second act is the confrontation. The third act contains the climax and denouement. Often the first act is about 30 minutes, the second act about 60 minutes, and the third act about 30 minutes.

It is the beginning of another act/scene and punctuated as distinct from the other parts of the dramatic structure.
